### 關於我們 ABOUT US

和諧之家成立於1985年,是全港第一間為受虐婦女及其子女提供庇護服務的機構。至今已發展成為一站式的家暴防治中心,以多元化預防、治療及發展服務,協助受家暴影響的家庭,並透過不同類型的社區教育活動,推廣和諧健康的家庭關係。此外,機構更爲跨專業人士提供培訓,並倡議政策及法律的改革。

Harmony House was established in 1985 as the first shelter for abused women and their children in Hong Kong. Today, we have developed into a one-stop anti-domestic violence service agency, with a wide range of preventive, therapeutic and developmental programmes to help families affected by domestic violence. We also organise community education programmes, promote harmonious and healthy family relationships, provide training to multi-disciplinary and advocate for policies and legislations on behalf of victims of violence, their families and communities.

### 主席的話 CHAIRPERSON'S REMARKS



隨著一年結束之際,我感到自豪可在年度報告致辭。保護兒童是我們今年的重點主題,相信大家亦有所共鳴。 每一位兒童應在安全和充滿關愛的環境中成長,但不幸地,家庭暴力儼如無聲的流行病存在於社會上,讓不 同背景、經濟狀況或地域的家庭也有機會受其影響。

### 讓人憂慮的現況

我們看到虐兒個案的呈報數字大幅飆升。根據社會福利署「保護兒童資料系統統計報告」,虐兒個案由2020 年的940宗躍升至2023年的1.457宗,增幅超過50%,情況令人憂慮。這些個案的分類為:

身體虐待:41%性虐待:35%疏忽照顧:21%

這些數字並非單純的統計數字,而是實實在在的生命、創傷和求救,需要我們切實的救援、支援及作出預防工作。

### 我們承諾的改變

爲了培育下一代得以健康成長,社會上各持份者必須締造以兒童安全爲先的支援環境。在香港賽馬會慈善信託基金、中銀香港百週年慈善基金及其他捐助機構的持續支持下,過去一年,我們在保護兒童的服務上取得 重大進展。

我們推行了多元化的服務,包括:

- · 兒童情緒教育
- · 家長教育
- · 壓力舒緩活動

### 親子活動

我們透過上述活動接觸到超過9,600名的學童和家長。服務不僅讓兒童學習和了解自己的情緒,培養他們自 我保護的能力,家長亦得以學習善意溝通、同理心、正向管教和自我關懷。可見,教育、訓練和良好實踐三 管齊下,是預防虐待兒童的有效方法。

### 致力協作

我們與相關政府部門、社會福利機構及學術團體合作,致力保護兒童免受傷害。今年,我們爲106間機構提供近50場的培訓和分享講座,超過1,300名專業人士參與其中,包括來自香港、內地和澳門的教師、社工、輔導員和醫護人員。這些持份者在識別及介入虐兒個案的能力亦有所提高。

### 倡導和未來方向

我們的使命是爲受家暴影響的家庭進行倡導,力求不斷改善政策、資助和支援系統,以助他們開創新生活。 展望未來,我們將專注於擴大我們的預防教育工作,主要針對支援邊緣社群,特別是少數族裔家庭。我們的 目標是營造一個讓每名兒童感到安全、受到支持和重視的成長環境。

As we conclude another year, it is with immense pride that I present my remarks for our annual report. This year, our focus is on a theme that resonates deeply with all of us: **Child Protection**. Every child deserves to grow up in a safe and loving environment. Unfortunately, family violence may occur as a silent endemic, affecting families across all demographics, regardless of background, economic status or location.

### The Alarming Reality

We have witnessed a troubling rise in child abuse reports. According to the Social Welfare Department Child Protection Registry Statistical Report, the number of child abuse cases has surged by over 50%, increasing from 940 cases in 2020 to 1,457 cases in 2023. The breakdown of these cases reveals that:

- Physical Abuse: 41%
- Sexual Abuse: 35%
- Neglect: 21%

These figures are not mere statistics but indicating real lives, real trauma and real call for rescue, help and prevention.

### Our Commitment to Change

To foster the healthy development of future generations, it is vital for community stakeholders to create supportive environment that place child safety at high priority. With the ongoing support of the Hong Kong Jockey Club Charities Trust, Bank of China Hong Kong Centennial Charitable Foundation, and various other funders, we have made significant strides in our child protection initiatives over the past year.

We have implemented a diverse range of services including:

- Children's Emotion Education
- Parental Education
- Stress-relief Activities

### Parent-child Activities

These programmes have reached over 9,600 students and parents. Not only do the programmes equip children with the knowledge to understand their emotion and develop self-protection skills, but empowering parents to acquire compassionate communication, empathy, positive parenting and self-care awareness. Evidently, education, training and good practice are the effective 3-pronged approach to prevent child abuse.

### Collaborative Efforts

Our commitment to protecting children from harm extends to collaboration with relevant government departments, NGOs, and academic institutions. This year, we provided nearly 50 training and sharing sessions for 106 organisations, accomplishing training for over 1,300 professionals, including teachers, social workers, counsellors, and healthcare practitioners from Hong Kong, Mainland and Macau. These stakeholders have attained higher competence to identify and intervene in cases of child abuse.

### Advocacy and Future Directions

It is our mission to advocate for constant improvement in policies, funding, and support system for families in need. Looking ahead, we will focus on expanding our prevention programmes, particularly those addressing the unique challenges faced by marginalized communities, especially ethnic minority families. Our goal is to cultivate an environment where every child feels safe, supported, and valued.

### Gratitude

Finally, I should extend my earnest appreciation to each of our funders, donors, corporate partners, board members, volunteers and staff for the invaluable and unwavering dedication to our mission. Together, we shall endeavor to "Helping Victims, Saving Lives, Training Professionals and Eliminating Domestic Violence"!

### 總幹事報告 EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

我充滿著感激和反思,回顧過去一年在和諧之家所經歷的難忘旅程。本人很榮幸回顧及滙報 各服務的進度和表現。

我們的婦女及兒童庇護中心致力提供即時性安全、支援和資源轉介服務予受虐的婦女和其子女,並一直維持著高水平的24小時服務,過去一年,悉心照顧330名入住庇護中心的婦女和兒童。除了個案入住外,我們透過24小時婦女求助熱線接獲8,400多個求助電話,當中有6,338個來電與家暴相關,其中更有三成需於午夜安排入住。我們深信本會的熱線爲處於危機中的婦女提供24小時的服務尤其重要,特別是她們在最需要支援的絕望時刻,我們可即時向她們提供援助。

承蒙香港賽馬會慈善信託基金的捐助,「賽馬會『童』 抱抱計劃」於去年10月開展,旨在及早識別有虐待兒 童風險的家庭。由本計劃提供的高質兒童治療小組和 親職教育小組,深受學校和家長的歡迎,去年提供 逾220節的小組,多達1,500學生和家長人次受惠 此外,透過情緒教育活動,我們共服務了4,663位兒 童,更爲2,475位兒童進行了家暴評估,我們發現當 中分別有66%及40%的學童會目睹父母吵架及打架, 而且分別有58%和71%的學童表示曾被父母打駕。同 時,我們爲488名家長進行了身心倦怠情況調查。結 果發現,31%受訪家長的身心倦怠情況屬中等程度, 更有7%受訪家長屬嚴重程度。這些數據反映出我們必 須加強向父母提供親職教育,讓他們掌握正向育兒、 壓力管理和自我關懷的技巧,以防止虐待兒童的情況 在家庭發生。

「賽馬會跨步彩虹計劃」已進行了兩年。在過去一年,我們樂見「家庭頻道」深受大衆支持。通過「家庭頻道」提供了57場線上講座,共有4,450名觀衆參與其中,成績令人鼓舞。此外,我們的網上讀書小組亦廣受歡迎,透過好書閱讀及分享,讓參加者學習利用外部資源進行自我提升、以多元化觀點深入了解其原生家庭的複雜性和對他們人生不同階段的影響。我們透過具影響力的活動凝聚曾面對童年逆境創傷的同路人,讓他們互相支持及達致充權。我們將繼續推出有效的服務,接觸更多相關的服務受衆,以擴大此計劃的效益,並通過全方位的服務遏止跨代暴力的發生。

為實現家庭和諧及家暴零容忍的願景,男士支援服務是我們其中一項重中之重的服務。我們衷心感謝賽馬會慈善信託基金的捐助,賽馬會「男海啟航」支援計劃在2023年12月1日開展。為能接觸到更多男士,我們加以利用外展及網上服務模式,以激發男士到社會服務單位尋求協助。是項計劃主要特點是支援男士建立抗逆力和提升他們的人際關係技巧,並篩選有潛在需要的個案,讓他們及早獲得適切的社會服務。有鑒於社會上為男士提供的住宿服務有限,對於受家庭暴

力影響或因家庭衝突而遭受情緒困擾的男士,本計劃 將爲他們提供短期的酒店住宿及資源轉介支援服務, 同時亦會安排輔導服務,以協助男士改善個人及家庭 關係。

第四期的香港賽馬會社區資助計劃 - 「踏步向前」家暴防治計劃已踏入最後一年的計劃年度。與過去三期的計劃一樣,我們繼續透過線上和線下方式提供三個層面的介入服務。我們為處於家暴風險的家庭提供了380多場個案輔導和治療小組服務,共有700多名參加者受惠。在社區教育工作方面,我們去年爲專業人士和公衆舉辦跨專業培訓和社區教育活動,受惠人次多達141,000。我們教育大衆辨識及警惕家暴和虐兒的警號,並讓他們明白家庭衝突需及早求助的重要性。此計劃對社區有著積極正面的影響。爲期三年的新一期計劃將於2024年4月1日開展,我們期待新計劃在來年繼續提高服務成效,讓更多家庭受惠。

由中國銀行(香港)有限公司捐助的「40分鐘和諧心靈天地」計劃在其最後一年亦順利進行。本年度,我們為元朗區的本地及少數族裔家庭提供320節個案輔導,並舉辦逾105節的情緒覺察和善意溝通教育的兒童、家長及夫妻小組,受惠人次約670。此外,我們亦致力在元朗區推動共融教育服務,提供不同類型的活動讓多元種族人士進行交流,受惠人次多達1,600。透過加強在社區內推廣善意溝通,家庭可以營造一個富有同情心的溝通環境,鞏固他們彼此間的連繫,並增強家庭成員之間的理解。爲持續推廣非暴力溝通,我們致力物色其他的捐助,以支持此甚具意義的服務在新界北繼續推行。

展望未來,我們會繼續堅守打擊家庭暴力和兒童虐待。我們相信虐待事件可透過及早介入而得以減少傷害。我們將發展和推動更多的防治服務,旨在教育及提升高危群體就家庭關係、解決衝突和面對家暴的應對方法及技巧。我們亦會繼續與企業和機構合作,促進社區夥伴關係,合力提升社會對家暴議題的關注和支援家暴倖存者,爲受家暴影響的家庭建立一個強大的支援網。

在此,衷心感謝各撥款團體、董事局委員、各小組委員會成員、合作夥伴、義工和員工們。因著各位的熱誠、努力不懈和對我們機構使命的認同及肯定,和諧之家才可取得現有的成果。再次感謝大家一直的支持和奉獻。我們會繼續爲受家暴影響的家庭轉化其生命、重建有尊嚴的生活,並確保每位求助者獲得重視、支持和自信。

To review the past year, I filled with gratitude and reflection on the incredible journey I have taken at Harmony House. It is an honor to review and report the progress and performance of all services.

Our Shelter for Women and Children plays a vital role in providing immediate safety, support and resources for abused women and their children. We continued to maintaining a high standard of 24-hour emergency service for 330 women and children. Besides the case admissions, we have totally received over 8,400 calls through our 24-hour Women Hotline for crisis counselling and emotional support, of which 30% of the families were admitted at midnight and 6,338 calls are related to domestic abuse. We believe our hotline is crucial to provide around the clock support for female in crisis and offer them for help at the moments of desperation when they need support the most.

With the grant from the Hong Kong Jockey Club Charities Trust, a new project "Jockey Club Project Harmony Bubbles" for early identification of families with at-risk child abuse issues was launched in October last year. The project provided edge-cutting children therapeutic and parenting groups with many positive responses, the total number of parents and children served is over 220 group sessions and 1,500 participants. In addition, we reached out to 4,663 children through our emotion education programmes, which we have provided risk assessments of domestic violence for 2,475 children. Among them, we found that 66% and 40% of them had witnessed their parents quarrelling and fighting respectively, and 58% and 71% of them reported they had been physically abused and verbally abused by their parents respectively. At the same time, we also conducted a survey on perceived burnout of 488 parents. The results revealed that 31% of the respondents experienced moderate levels of burnout, with 7% classified as severe. These figures reflected more education services should be provided to parents on positive parenting techniques, stress management, and self-care practices to prevent child abuse at home settings.

The "Jockey Club Project Stride" was in its second year of operation. During the year, we were delighted to see that the "Family Channel" becomes popular among the public. 57 online talks were provided through the Channel with 4,450 audiences. This result was so encouraging. Our Online Reading Club was also very popular. Through reading and sharing good reference books, all participants will learn to utilize external resources for self-improvement and gaining insights of the complexities and impact of their family of origin upon their different life stages. These programmes are powerful to join people with adverse childhood experiences for mutual support and empowerment. We will continue to launch these effective tools to reach out more potential service users to scale up its impact and combating the intergenerational cycle of violence through holistic services in the community.

Men support service is one of our paramount concern to foster the vision of family harmony and zero tolerance of domestic violence. We are grateful to the funding support from the Hong Kong Jockey Club Charities Trust, the "Jockey Club Project Ocean: Men Support Service" was launched on 1 December 2023. In this project, we are utilizing an outreach and online service mode to reach out to more men and motivate them to seek assistance from social service units. Our main objective is to support men in building resilience and enhancing their interpersonal relationship skills, as well as to screen for cases with potential needs so that they can receive appropriate social services in a timely manner. In view of limited accommodation service for male in the society, for who are being affected by domestic violence or experiencing emotional distress caused by family conflicts, we would

provide a short term hotel accommodation and referral support for them. Counselling services would also be rendered to helping them improve their personal and family relationships.

The Phase Four Hong Kong Jockey Club Charities Trust Community Project Grant: Moving Forward Against Domestic Violence Project was in its final year of operation. Same as the past three phases, we continued to provide three levels of intervention services through online and offline means. Over 380 sessions of counselling and therapeutic group services were offered for families at risk of domestic violence and more than 700 participants were served. In the community education service, we held multi-disciplinary trainings and community education programmes for professionals and the public, with a total of 141,000 person times was served in last year. We have educated families to alert the warning signs of domestic violence and child abuse and be aware of help seeking at an early stage of family conflicts. We are proud of the positive impact has been made in the community by this project. The new phase of 3-year project would be launched on 1 April 2024. We look forward to enhancing the service outcomes of this project in the years to come.

The "40 Minutes @ Harmony Space" Project sponsored by the Bank of China (Hong Kong) Limited was also carried out successfully in its final year. During the year, 320 sessions of casework counselling were provided to local and ethnic minority families in Yuen Long and 105 sessions of group on emotional awareness and compassionate communication education were organised for children, parents and couples, benefiting nearly 670 participants. In addition, we have been committed to promote inclusive education services in Yuen Long by providing different activities for multi-cultural community and more than 1,600 participants were served. By enhancing the promotion of compassionate communication in the community, families can cultivate an environment where compassionate communication flourishes, strengthening their bonds and enhancing understanding among family members. To sustain the continuous promotion of non-violent communication, we target to seek alternative funding to support this meaningful service in the northern part of New Territories.

Looking ahead, we remain steadfast in our commitment to fighting domestic violence and child abuse. Early intervention can lead to significant reductions in instances of abuse. We plan to develop and implement more preventative programmes aimed at educating at-risk populations about healthy family relationships, conflict resolution, and coping mechanisms. We will also continue to foster community partnerships and engage different corporates and organisations in our efforts to raise awareness and support for survivors. Together, we can build a robust supportive network for affected families.

I would like to express my deepest gratitude to everyone involved with Harmony House. Our funders, board members, committee members, collaborative partners, volunteers, and staffs are the heart of our organisation. Your compassion, tireless efforts and commitment to our mission make all of our achievements possible. Thank you again for your ongoing support and dedication. We will continue to transform lives, foster dignity, and ensure that every person who comes through our doors feels valued, supported, and empowered.

### 服務內容 SERVICE DESCRIPTIONS

### 01 》 24小時婦女求助熱線及跟進服務 24-hour Women Hotline and Follow-up Services

24小時婦女求助熱線於1986年設立,爲正受家庭 暴力問題困擾的求助者,提供卽時情緒支援及輔 導。在2023/24年度,熱線共接獲8,404個求助電 話,當中約75% (卽6,338個)涉及家庭暴力問題; 而最後共有330名婦女及兒童透過熱線轉介入住庇 護中心。另外,當中有62個家庭(30%)是午夜入 住的,可見24小時熱線能收卽時緊急支援之效。

自2003年10月起,熱線爲致電求助但未有入住庇 護中心及缺乏社會服務支援的受虐婦女提供情緒 支援及輔導跟進服務,目的是協助她們建立社區 支援網絡,加強她們對家庭暴力及自我保護的認 知。我們去年共有62個新的熱線跟進個案。


Our 24-hour women hotline has been providing immediate emotional support and counselling to callers affected by domestic violence since 1986. In 2023/24, 8,404 calls were received and around 75% (6,338 calls) were related to domestic violence. From these calls. 330 women and their children were admitted to our shelter, of which 62 families (30%) were admitted at midnight. These figures show that the 24-hour hotline service plays a significant role in providing round-the-clock immediate protection for battered women and their children.

Since October 2003, the hotline service has been modified to include follow-up services for phone-in victims who did not feel the need to take refuge in the shelter but were still in need of other supportive services. Accordingly, these non-residential service users received emotional support and psychosocial counselling. This has helped them re-establish social support networks, heightened their awareness of domestic violence, and enhanced their knowledge of self-protection. Last year, we provided follow-up services via the hotline to 62 new clients.






### 02》 庇護住宿服務 Refuge Service





### 婦女與施虐者的年齡 Age of Women and Perpetrators









### 離舍時婚姻狀況 Marital Status at the Time of Discharge











Types of Abuse Witnessed by Children (More than one choice may be selected)




### 兒童目睹家暴的情緒反應 (可選擇多項)

Emotional Response of Children Witnessing Domestic Violence (More than one choice may be selected)




### 兒童目睹家暴的行爲反應 (可選擇多項)



We used various methods to help abusers improved their behaviour, assisted victims and children who witnessed domestic violence in expressing their emotions and overcoming trauma, and equipped parents with positive parenting skills to improve family relationships.

# 02》【家長情緒教育 - 醫·教·社新動力】周年論壇

### Forum on "Parental Emotional Education - New Driving Force by Multi-disciplinary"

去年,我們於11月24日舉辦了【家長情緒教育-醫 教: 社新動力】周年論壇,除了激請個案到場親身 講述身爲家長所面對的親職壓力,以及期望社會 和學校如何進一步支援家長及兒童以減少情緒困 擾外,亦請來精神科專科醫生崔永豪醫生、香港 大學社會工作及社會行政學系名譽副教授曾潔雯 博士,太平紳士,以及樂善堂楊仲明學校蕭子亮 校長爲主講嘉賓,從醫護界、社福界和教育界一 同探討如何透過提升家長情緒管理的能力、減低 管教壓力、改善及培養正向親子關係,共同守護 兒童在安全愉快的環境茁壯成長。

當日超過160位參加者出席活動,並在開放討論時 段踴躍提問,與台上的嘉賓講者彼此進行討論、 分享及交流,從中得以互相啟發,了解到家長管 教子女的難處和需要,並喚起大衆對家長情緒教 育的關注。

Last year, our Annual Forum held on 24 November, featured "Parental Emotional Education-New Driving Force by Multi-disciplinary". We invited a parent to share her parental pressure and how the community and schools can further support both parents and children to reduce emotional stress. Dr. William Chui, a Specialist in Psychiatry, Dr. Sandra Tsang, JP, Honorary Associate Professor and Department of Social Work and Administration from the University of Hong Kong, Principal Mr. Siu Tsz Leung of Lok Sin Tong Yeung Chung Ming Primary School were the Forum keynote speakers to explore how to enhance parents' emotional management capabilities, reduce parenting pressure, improve and nurture positive parent-child relationships, protect and enable children to thrive in a safe and happy environment.

More than 160 participants attended the Forum. There were active discussions and sharing, and both the keynote speakers and the participants have inspired one another with different approaches to parenting and parental emotional education. These exchanges helped demonstrate a deeper understanding of the needs of parents and aroused public's awareness of parental emotional education.









### 03 》 義工訓練 Volunteer Training

我們定期招募義工接聽24小時婦女求助熱線。在 義工正式投入服務前,本機構先安排基礎義工訓 練課程,內容包括:評估及輔導技巧、服務須知 及守則等,讓義工能有充份準備,透過熱線服務 幫助受家暴困擾的人士。此外,我們亦會舉辦進 階培訓、交流及康樂活動,加強義工對服務的興 趣及團隊歸屬感。去年,本會的熱線義工共提供 了280節的熱線支援服務。



除了熱線支援服務外,我們的義工團隊爲機構 提供各種支援服務,包括地區服務推廣、兒童 關顧、文書工作等。去年義工參與的服務時數接 近800小時。他們的參與有助於社區內宣揚關注家 庭暴力的重要訊息。

We regularly recruit volunteers to man our 24-hour Women Hotline. All volunteers must complete our basic volunteer training course before they can begin their service. The course includes assessment and counselling skills, service guidelines and rules etc., to fully prepare them to help domestic violence victims. We also organise advanced trainings and recreational activities to enhance volunteers' interests in voluntary services and their sense of belonging towards the team. Last year, our volunteers provided 280 Women Hotline support sessions.



Apart from hotline support services, our volunteers have also helped with Harmony House service promotion in the community, childcare and clerical work. They contributed nearly 800 service hours last year and their participation is paramount towards awareness of domestic violence in the community.

### 04》 網上暴力危機自我評估 Online Self-assessment Tool

我們深信自我保護和自我辨認對預防家庭暴力非 常重要。因此,我們於2011年設立網上自我評估 工具,讓社會大衆及早辨識家庭暴力,以便盡快 尋求專業人員協助。去年,522人於本會網站完成 網上評估,並有多達109,000人瀏覽本會網頁。

We believe the ability of self-defense and self-diagnosis are both important for prevention to domestic violence. Thus, in 2011, we developed an online self-assessment tool to help individuals identify potential domestic violence risk so they can seek professional assistance as soon as possible. Last year, a total of 522 individuals used this online tool and up to 109,000 individuals visited our webpage.

### 傳媒聯絡 Media Contact

我們常主動連繫不同的傳媒伙伴,就虐兒、目睹 家暴兒童、男士困境及家長育兒困難等議題進行 訪談,並分享本會多元化的預防及支援服務。我 們希望透過傳媒訪問,加強公衆預防家庭暴力的 意識,推廣非暴力溝通及和諧家庭訊息,鼓勵受 虐人士求助,並推廣機構服務給予更多受家庭暴 力困擾的人士。



We often approach different media partners for interviews on issues such as child abuse, children witnessing domestic violence, situation of male victims and parenting difficulties. We also share our preventive and support services for service users. Through media interviews, we aimed to enhance public awareness of the prevention of domestic violence, promote non-violent communication and family harmony, encourage the victims of domestic violence to proactively seek help and introduce our services to more victims and their families.

### 個案及輔導服務 Case Work and Counselling Services

在2023/24年度,我們爲65個個案提供輔導服 務,協助個案敍述和探索在童年時所經歷的逆境 經驗,幫助他們辨識和理解童年逆境所引發的情 感反應,如何影響他們的日常生活、人際關係和 心理健康。個案透過探索原生家庭的成長經驗, 減少了童年逆境經驗的情緒傷痛,活出自愛和自 主的生活,並建立尊重和健康的人際關係。



In 2023/24, we provided counselling services for a total of 65 cases. Through individual counselling, we helped clients explore their childhood adversities. This involves assisting the client in describing and exploring the trauma they experienced during their childhood, thereby helping them identify and understand the emotional responses triggered by these childhood adversities and how these emotions impact their daily lives, relationships, and mental well-being. Through exploring their personal growth in original family, they can reduce the emotional impacts of childhood adversity, restore self-love autonomy in their life and establish respectful and healthy interpersonal relationships with others.

# 03 》 社區教育活動 Community Education Programmes

We delivered education talks at tertiary institutions, primary schools, and kindergartens with the objectives to increase tertiary students and parents awareness on the intergenerational transmission of domestic violence.

We also launched an online "Family Channel", which regularly provides "family" related online talks for the public. The talks delved into various topics such as the impact of adverse childhood experiences, school bullying, promoting positive parenting through a strengths-based approach, and navigating the challenges of children dealing with ADHD. On average, each online session attracted almost 170 participants. We are delighted to see that the "Family Channel" is welcomed by the public.

### Training for Multi-disciplinary

This year, we organised professional trainings for social work students, social workers, counselors, and other social service professionals. We were honoured to participate in professional knowledge-sharing sessions with various professionals, including doctors, nurses, school principals, and social workers, at the Kwun Tong Service Coordination Meeting on Child Abuse organised by the Social Welfare Department. Through the professional training, participants learned the concept of Adverse Childhood Experiences (ACEs) and gained valuable insights into the persistence of violence across generations. The training also equipped them with essential skills and knowledge to assess and manage ACE-related cases, acquired proficiency in case assessment techniques, as well as appropriate intervention and support strategies.

### 04》 社交媒體運動 Social Media Campaigns

去年,我們發起「童年記憶樹」的線上社交媒體 運動,旨在建立社區支持,讓參與者得到相互支 持並分享成長經歷。這使參與者能夠深化他們 的經歷和思考,找到共鳴和理解。該活動獲得 了顯著的正面回饋,共收到37個投稿,觸及超過 160,000人。

此外,我們還推出了「童年留聲機」的線上社交 媒體運動,旨在展示增強內在韌性的童年正向經 驗(PCEs),提高公衆對童年創傷的認識,明白身 邊重要人物的重要性和意義。我們總共收到23個 投稿,觸及超過90,000人。兩項活動成功引起大衆 共鳴,並促進個人成長和社會關懷意識。

Last year, we launched an online social media campaign "Childhood Memory Tree" aimed at establishing community support, enabling participants to gain mutual support and share their growth experiences. This allowed participants to deepen their experiences and thoughts, finding resonance and understanding. The campaign received positive feedback, with a total of 37 submissions and reaching over 160,000 individuals.

On the other hand, another social media campaign "Childhood Phonograph" highlighted positive childhood experiences and resilience-building stories of those who have overcome adverse childhood experiences. It emphasized the role of supportive figures and raised public awareness about childhood trauma. This campaign garnered 23 submissions, reaching over 90,000 individuals. Both campaigns successfully resonated with audiences and contributed to promoting personal growth and social care awareness.



Peer support service "Buddies" gathering has been developed substantially with new members joining and in various activities, such as co-learning group on "Storytelling with Playback Theatre", art expression activities, festival celebration programmes, MBTI psychology education workshop, and mindfulness outdoor activity. All these Buddies workshops aim to facilitate communication, relaxation and self-expression among member, help Buddies develop self-awareness, expression abilities and teamwork skills, as well as restore their inner harmony and strengthen the balance of body-mind-spirit.

The Buddies have been actively contributed and involved in our various services, including family of origin therapy groups, school talks, project sharing sessions, and service exhibition working groups. By sharing their experiences and stories, it facilitated the interaction and engagement among participants, deepened participants' understanding of their original family. The efforts of the Buddies also left a significant impact on the public and our service beneficiaries.

# 賽馬會「男海啟航」支援計劃 **JOCKEY CLUB PROJECT OCEAN: MEN SUPPORT SERVICE**



由賽馬會慈善信託基金捐助的賽馬會「男海啟航」支援計劃 於2023年12月1日開展。現今男士除了承受個人經濟、身 份與地位的壓力外,還面對其他不同人生挑戰,包括中年 危機、健康問題、伴侶關係衝突、親職教育、職場關係衝 突等。故是項計劃主要特點是支援男士建立抗逆力和提升 他們人際關係技巧,並篩查有潛在需要協助的個案,讓他 們及早獲得適切的社會服務。爲接觸更多男士宣傳計劃, 我們加以利用外展及網上服務模式,以激發男士尋求協助 的意願

The "Jockey Club Project Ocean: Men Support Service" was funded by the Hong Kong Jockey Club Charities Trust. It was launched on 1 December 2023. Nowadays, men are not only bearing the pressures of personal economics, identity, and status, they also face other different life challenges, including midlife crises, health problems, partner relationship conflicts, parenting education, and workplace relationship conflicts. The key features of this project are to support men in building resilience and enhancing their interpersonal relationship skills, as well as to screen for cases with potential needs so that they can receive appropriate social services in a timely manner. In order to reach more men for service promotion, we are utilizing an outreach and online service mode to enhance men's willingness on help seeking.

### 01 》 個案及輔導服務 Casework and Counselling Services

在2023/24年度,我們共有9個個案,當中包括家 暴受虐男士及其家庭成員,他們主要面對婚姻問 題及管教困擾。求助個案主要透過男士熱線、社 工轉介和WhatsApp與我們接觸。

In 2023/24, we provided intensive counselling and support to 9 cases, including male victims of domestic violence and their family members. The cases mostly encountered marital problem and difficulties in parenting. They primarily contacted us through our MAN Hotline, social worker's referral and WhatsApp.

### 02》 小組工作 Group Work

### 爸爸/親子/男士治療小組

To enhance interpersonal skills at work, including emotional self-regulation, effective communication techniques and stress management etc., thereby enhancing coping abilities that can be transferred from work to family situations for improving family relationships.

### 03 》 社區教育活動 Community Education Programmes

### 短期「避靜」住宿服務 Short-Term "Calm Down" Accommodation Services

爲面對家庭暴力或因家庭衝突引發情緒困擾的男 士提供最多爲期7天的短暫「避靜」酒店住宿及資源 轉介支援服務,同時亦會安排輔導服務,以協助 男士重塑個人及家庭關係。

We provide up to 7 days of temporary "respite" hotel accommodation and referral support to those men who are being affected by domestic violence or experiencing emotional distress caused by family conflicts. Counselling services would be provided for them at the same time helping them to rebuild their personal and family relationships.

### 05 計劃宣傳及推廣 Publicity and Promotion of the Project

自2023年12月1日至2024年3月31日,我們運用了 多元方式進行宣傳推廣,包括單張派發、電台宣傳 及社交平台媒體等,向社會大衆宣傳計劃內容。同 時,我們運用了藍色結合橙色的標誌,以吸引大 衆的眼球,增加對計劃認識的興趣。

During the period from 1 December 2023 to 31 March 2024, we used a variety of methods for publicity and promotion for getting the public to know about the project, including leaflet distribution, radio airtime, and social media platforms. At the same time, we used an eye-catching colour tone, blue and orange, to design a Project Logo, which aims to attract the public's attention and increase their interest in learning about our project.



# 和諧徑 HARMONY LANE

和諧徑於2011年成立,位於葵靑區石籬邨。承蒙香港賽馬會慈善信託基金的捐助,和諧徑於2023年10月開展了爲期三年的「賽馬會『童』抱抱計劃」。計劃旨在保護兒童免受暴力傷害,同時關注家長的親職壓力問題。和諧徑提供多元化的兒童情緒教育服務、家長教育及舒壓活動、親子活動和社區教育活動,以預防虐兒及家暴問題的發生。

Harmony Lane was established in 2011 and is located in Shek Lei Estate, Kwai Tsing District. With the support of the Hong Kong Jockey Club Charities Trust, "Jockey Club Harmony Bubbles Project" was launched in October 2023 for a period of three years. The project aims to protect children from violence and also address parental stress issues. Harmony Lane provides a diverse range of services including children's emotional education, parental education and stress-relief activities, parent-child activities, and community education activities to prevent child abuse and domestic violence.

## 服務內容 SERVICE DESCRIPTIONS

### 01 》 個案及輔導服務 Casework and Counselling Services

在2023/24年度,我們合共支援25位兒童及其家庭,並為他們及其家人提供了148節輔導服務,當中包括了個人輔導及遊戲治療服務。

In 2023/24, we supported a total of 25 children and their families, providing them with 148 counselling sessions, including individual counselling and play therapy.

### 02》 小組工作 Group Work

兒童情緒教育及治療小組爲有潛在家暴問題的學生而設,讓他們認識情緒、暴力種類和自我保護的方法,同時透過藝術,讓他們表達及處理負面情緒和創傷。於2023/24年度,我們分別於幼稚園及小學舉辦了13個兒童小組。

家長小組方面,我們共設兩個主題,分別是「正向教養家長小組」及「自我關懷家長小組」,分別教授家長正向管教技巧及提升家長照顧自己身心靈的能力,從而改善親子關係。於2023/24年度,我們合共舉辦了20個家長小組。

The Children Emotional Education and Therapeutic Group is designed for students who have potential domestic violence issues. It helps them understand emotions, types of violence, and methods of self-protection. Through art, it also allows them to express and process negative emotions and trauma. In 2023/24, we held a total of 13 children groups in kindergartens and primary schools.

We offered two main parent groups, i.e. "Positive Parenting Group" and "Self-Compassion Parent Group" which taught parents positive parenting skills and enhanced their ability to care for their own well-being respectively, with the aim to improve parent-child relationships. In 2023/24, we organized a total of 20 parent groups.

我們相信提升兒童的內在資源,包括情緒管理技 巧、抗逆力和社交技巧等,將能更有效地應對生 活中的逆境及保護自己。故此,我們透過不同的 教育活動,包括講座、故事坊、體驗活動和「和 諧快線」情緒教育車,讓全港小學及幼稚園的學 童認識情緒,掌握正面表達情緒的方法,以及提 升自我保護的能力。

於2023/24年度,我們分別於多間幼稚園及小學舉 辦了142節教育活動,共接觸到多達4,663位學童。

我們亦十分關注家長教育,除了正向教養講座, 我們亦提供多項家長舒壓活動,提升家長自我關 懷的意識。本年度,我們舉辦了52節家長活動, 共接觸到714位家長。

We believe that by enhancing children's inner resources, including emotional management skills, resilience, and social skills, they will be better equipped to cope with adversities in life and protect themselves. Therefore, through various educational activities such as talks, storytelling workshops, experiential activities, and the "Harmony Express" mobile education vehicle, we aim to help students in schools and kindergartens understand emotions, learn positive ways to express emotions, and develop self-protection skills.

In 2023/24, we held 142 educational activities in kindergartens and primary schools, reaching up to 4,663 students.

We also place great emphasis on parent education. In addition to positive parenting seminars, we provide various stress-relief activities for parents to enhance their self-care awareness. This year, we organised 52 parent activities, reaching out to 714 parents.

在2023/24年度,我們舉行了142節兒童教育活 動,共服務了4,663位兒童。當中更爲2,967兒童進 行了家暴評估。調查中,我們發現分別有66.1%及 40.4%的受訪學童表示曾目睹父母吵架及打架;另 分別有70.8%及58.3%的受訪學童表示曾被家人罵 及打。

與此同時,我們爲488家長進行了身心倦怠情況調

In 2023/24, we reached out to 4,663 students in 142 sessions of emotional education programmes and conducted risk assessments of domestic violence with 2,967 children. According to the questionnaires, 66.1% and 40.4% of respondents witnessed quarrels and brawls between family members respectively; 70.8% and 58.3% of respondents were scolded and battered by family member respectively.

At the same time, we conducted a survey on perceived burnout of 488 parents. The results revealed that 30.9% of the respondents experienced moderate levels of burnout, with 7% classified as severe. The overall average score was 42.4 (a score between 50-70 indicates moderate level). The situation calls for attention.
















### 學童曾目睹家人吵架 Witnessed Quarrels between Family Members







### 04》 跨界別專業培訓 Training for Multi-disciplinary

在預防及處理家庭暴力的問題上,不同專業界別人士的參與十分重要。透過與各專業人士的接觸和交流,包括:老師、社工及幼兒照顧員,我們可以及早識別出受家暴影響或目睹家暴的兒童,關注他們和家人的需要,並提供適切的支援。同時,透過專業分享,加強同工對虐兒個案的敏感度,以及應對受虐兒童和目睹家暴兒童的技巧。

在2023/24年度,我們舉辦共22節專業培訓,與404 位專業人士分享了如何識別受家暴影響的兒童及他 們所需的支援服務。 To prevent and handle domestic violence cases, the involvement and communication amongst professionals, such as teachers, social workers and childcare workers are crucial. This helps identify children who are either experiencing abuse or witnessing domestic violence at home, and provides them with appropriate services to meet their needs. At the same time, sharing between professionals can also strengthen the sensitivity of workers on detecting child abuse cases and enhance their skills on handling such cases.

In 2023/24, we conducted 22 sessions of professional training for 404 professional workers. We shared our experiences on identifying children who are affected by domestic violence and the supportive services they need.



「40分鐘和諧心靈天地」計劃由中國銀行(香港)有限公司捐助,於2021年在元朗市中心設立了和諧家庭空間,爲該區人士提供空間去靜心、療癒及學習善意溝通。「善意溝通」提倡一種非暴力的正向方式表達自我,以應對個人情緒、家庭及日常人際關係。此計劃的活動多元化,鼓勵大家關心個人的身心靈健康,從我心和諧開始,建立和諧家庭、共建友愛社區。

The "40 Minutes@Harmony Space" project was funded by the Bank of China (Hong Kong) Limited. Family Harmony Space was established in 2021. The Centre was located in Yuen Long town centre, providing a place to relax, heal and learn "compassionate communication".

"Compassionate communication" encourages honest and non-violent self-expressions to cope with intra/ inter-personal relationships. Ultimately, one can achieve a balanced body-mind-spirit and take part in building a harmonious family as well as a loving community.

We hosted compassionate communication groups at Family Harmony Space, kindergartens and primary schools in the district. Targets were children, parents and couples. We aim to advocate the use of non-violent and positive ways of self-expression to cope with personal emotions, family and interpersonal relationships.

We promote respectful parenting through family activities, encourage parents to practise self-care and show empathy, and thus nurture children with empathy, building harmonious family relationships.

### 04》 和諧心靈角落 Harmony Corner

和諧家庭空間運用「五感」的概念為區內人士打造一個實踐靜心和疏理負面情緒的空間。中心以大自然作為設計主題,配合翠綠的植物、柔和的大自然音樂及各類含靜心元素的活動,提供予社區人士使用,鼓勵大家關心個人的身心靈健康。

Family Harmony Space utilized the "five senses concept" to create a space for the community to practise mindfulness and deal with their negative emotions. Decorated with greenery, soft music and natural elements, the Centre provides a pleasant atmosphere for the community to relax, encouraging everyone to achieve a balanced body-mind-spirit.

In 2023/24, we conducted 323 sessions of different activities, including storytelling, mindfulness exercise, art and horticulture experience and festival celebration etc., reached 1,769 person times in total.

# NVC Game Cards (2nd Edition)

The 1st edition NVC game card was a big hit and 800 sets were all distributed. Therefore, we released the 2nd edition, with revision by adding 6 "Feeling" cards and 4 "Need" cards. Mindful activities and practices of love language are newly added at the back of each card, hoping to encourage more sharing of feelings and needs among families and foster intimate family relationships.

### 《非暴力溝通與和諧家庭關係》研究報告

我們與香港樹仁大學合作進行為期兩年的學術研究 項目圓滿結束,並出版了《非暴力溝通與和諧家庭 關係》研究報告。

### 研究報告顯示

- (1) 單次性的善養孩子工作坊對於家長學習善養孩子方式及非暴力溝通方法有顯著成效,適合初學者去探索非暴力溝通,讓他們有所反思,並能夠提高他們善待孩子的意識。
- (2) 兒童小組對提升兒童的觀察力和情緒智商有顯著成效,他們能夠敏銳地覺察和同理別人的感受。
- (3) 家長小組對改善親子教養方式有顯著成效。家 長能以不批判的態度去觀察孩子的行為,理解 孩子的感受和需要。同時家長主動向孩子多表 達自己感受,並開始辨識到發出邀請和施加命 令的分別。
- (4) 夫妻小組讓參與者明白聆聽和顧及伴侶感受和需要的重要性。除了有助促進夫妻關係外,亦有助他們關注和重視個人感受,願意更主動和清晰地向伴侶表達自己的需要,提高了善待自己的意識。

# Non-violent Communication and Harmony Family Relationship Research Report

We conducted a 2-year study in collaboration with Hong Kong Shue Yan University and published the "Non-violent Communication and Harmony Family Relationship" research report.

Research findings suggested that

- (1) One-off NVC workshop is beneficial for parents, especially NVC beginners, in increasing self-awareness of their own parenting style and learning NVC through self-reflection.
- (2) Children group is effective in improving children's ability in observing and empathizing people's feelings
- (3) Parents group is effective in cultivating non-judgmental attitude, understanding, and mutuality in parent-child relationship. Parents started to distinguish the difference between request and demand.
- (4) Participants in couples group understood the importance of active listening in their spousal relationship and showed greater awareness of self-care. They were willing to take initiative expressing their needs and feelings clearly and concisely to their partners.

研究報告總結非暴力溝通的相關服務仍有很大的推 廣和發展空間,故此,我們會繼續在社區內推廣善 意溝通,以防止家庭暴力、促進家庭和諧為目標。



Research recommended that there are still great room for the development of nonviolent-communication-related service. We would continue to promote non-violent communication in the community, in order to prevent domestic violence and promote family harmony.



在和諧之家昨日舉行的第38周年大會暨「家長情緒教 育一醫·教·社新動力」周年論壇上,一名 SEN 兒童的 母親胡女士分享,她的孩子4歲時或於學校遇到令其受驚 的事情,不知道如何處理及向老師表達,以致情緒及精神 出現問題,更恐懼上學、坐立不安。其後,孩子更用肢體 攻擊胡女士以表達恐懼上學的情緒,例如搶手機等行為, 今胡女十崩潰。

胡女十表示,對如何安撫孩子的情绪及處理心理問題感到 很無助及不知所措,「我終日在嬰,更忍晤住對小朋方有語 言暴力,或關門隔開自己與小朋友。」為了幫助孩子,她找 到一些相關訓練及安排時間表,需要工作以支付高昂的費 用,承受很大精神壓力,經常失眠及感到低落

無奈的她後來向和諧之家求助,孩子獲安排了遊戲治療 服務,她亦接受了家長輔導服務,更在接受輔導期間,探 索到自己不自覺地逼迫孩子要達到合乎社會的標準,導致 自己容易發脾氣、容易證錯話傷害孩子,忽略其感受,影 響了親子關係。透過各類活動,胡女士紓緩了積存已久的 負面情緒,從而改變自己的態度,以平靜的心情對待孩

和諧之家計劃主任李嘉欣向香港文匯報表示,疫情因素 及社會氣氛緊張導致不少家庭關係惡劣,令虐兒事件頻 發。和諧之家此前訪問了125名幼稚園及小學學生家長, 發現近30%出現中度至嚴重的情緒倦怠情況。

The directors have the pleasure of presenting their annual report together with the audited financial statements of Harmony House Limited (the "Company") for the year ended 31 March 2024.

### PRINCIPAL ACTIVITY

The principal activity of the Company is to provide comprehensive services to individuals and families affected by domestic violence including a rent free shelter for abused women and children. Over the years, we have expanded our work to include therapeutic and preventative services that aim to help domestic violence victims of all genders and races with the goal of promoting harmonious family relationships. In addition, our activities also include community education, school outreach, crisis intervention, case counselling, supportive group therapy, hotline services, training to multi-disciplinary professionals, and advocacy for policies and legislations changes on behalf of victims of violence, their families and communities.

The shelter premises are provided by the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region.

### **BUSINESS REVIEW**

Established in 1985, Harmony House ("HH" or the "Agency") is a social service organization that is committed to eradicate domestic violence and promote harmonious and healthy family relationships. The Agency provides services and assistance to individuals and families that have encountered domestic violence and helps to raise community awareness on the importance of prevention, in our four service centres (one of which is a shelter), via three hotlines and through one mobile vehicle.

- The Shelter offers 73 beds (accommodation) and "after care" support, after departure from the Shelter, to battered women and their children, and girls from at-risk families.
- The Jockey Club Harmony Link Domestic Violence Prevention Centre provides therapeutic services to victims, batterers, children witnessing domestic violence, and other services such as arrangement of short-term accommodation for men facing family crisis, community education, training to multi-disciplinary professionals, and advocacy for polices and legislation changes that provides better support to victims of domestic violence.
- Harmony Lane Centre and the education "mobile truck" conduct outreach activities and programmes in schools for early identification of suspected child abuse victims and to promote child protection through parenting education.
- Family Harmony Space Centre promotes non-violent communication to improve family harmony for conflictual families of diverse cultural background and locals in Yuen Long.
- A 24-hour Woman Hotline, a Man Hotline and a Children Hotline offer crisis counselling and emotional support to those in need.

In the past year, HH has served 183,800 person-times through various services and projects offered to the different communities. The Shelter received over 8,400 calls and accommodated 330 abused women and children. The 24-hour Woman Hotline continues to provide immediate emotional support to those in need, and when abused victims check into the Shelter, they will also receive other supports such as contingency safety plan, vital information and relevant community resources. Victims with children also receive childcare support at the Shelter.

The Jockey Club "Harmony Bubbles" project launched in October 2023, with child protection service in mind, has reached out to over 4,600 school students on emotion education and approximately 2,500 of these students have participated in the risk assessment of domestic violence. Project 40 Minutes @ Harmony Space promotes and conducts non-violent communication education, provides trauma support work to individuals who had adverse childhood experiences and supportive service to men, with over 7,000 individuals benefited from the inspiring programmes and case counselling sessions. Our community education service and training for professionals have made significant impact to cover over 300 organizations including kindergartens, schools, government departments, NGOs and corporations on anti-domestic violence prevention. Another Jockey Club funded program, Project Stride, since commencing in October 2022 continued to help adults recover from their childhood traumatic domestic violence experience. The "Family Channel" in this project which is an online platform that delivers 24 sessions of family life education, had reached viewership of over 3,146.

### Financial Performance

HH's primary source of funds for the year was the subvention from the Social Welfare Department ("SWD"). Other ongoing funders included the Hong Kong Jockey Club Charities Trust ("HKJC"), which is one of the Agency's major funders, the Community Chest of Hong Kong, Bank of China (Hong Kong) Limited, Zonta Club of Kowloon, Help for Children, other corporate donors and individuals.

During the year, HKJC approved an additional \$16.18 million of funding to sponsor a new 3-year service, Project Harmony Bubbles which aims at child protection. The Zonta Club of Kowloon also donated \$160,000 to fund a 2-year project that provides support to new admission at the shelter.

The Agency has complied with all the requirements stipulated in the Social Welfare Department's Lump Sum Grant Manual, Lotteries Fund Manual, 16 Service Quality Standards (SOS) and Funding Service Agreement. Our Board of Directors (the "Board"), comprised of professionals from different disciplines and experiences, works closely with the senior management team to ensure that HH follows and applies the relevant legal obligations, including the Employment Ordinance and Personal Data (Privacy) Ordinance, in the operation of all its service units.

The five Board Committees, namely Staffing Committee, Finance Committee, Governance Committee, Service Development Management Committee and Renovation Committee have been delegated with the roles and responsibilities to improve HH's service provision, risk management, corporate governance, financial accountability and environmental safety.

### Key relationships

### (i) Service users

Our service users are mainly from abused families and at-risk families with conflicts. We serve all races and religions. Our service targets are abused women and their children, male and female batterers, male victims, abused elders, children witnessing domestic violence, parents facing parenting difficulties, abused children and the general public that would benefit from learning about domestic violence prevention and promotion of family harmony.

### (ii) Community stakeholders

The support of other community professionals is crucial to combating domestic violence. Ongoing collaboration with police, lawyers, medical practitioners, nurses, social workers, counsellors, teachers and academia are important work that the Agency engages in to enable us to better help abused families.

### (iii) Staff

As of 31 March 2024, we have a solid workforce of over 50 staff, comprising of Social Workers, Counsellors, Counselling Psychologists, Accounting and Information Technology professionals, and administrative and support staff to help deliver quality services and maintain efficiency in operating and running the Agency.

### (iv) Funders and external parties

The Agency works closely with government departments, funders and strategic partners to provide services to benefit those affected by domestic violence and the community as a whole. Throughout the year, our management and service unit supervisors joined a number of committees and working groups of different nature, run by the Social Welfare Department and Hong Kong Council of Social Service, to advocate for policies and service development relating to domestic violence issues. With these dedications, HH is continuous visioning in building a harmonious community without violence.

### Principal challenges and uncertainties

Over the years, the Agency has strived to increase services that provide more supportive and preventative measures and these are non-subvented projects which require ongoing funding. Sourcing and obtaining such fundings present uncertainties and challenges on service planning and sustainability. Project 40 Minutes @ Harmony Space sponsored by the Bank of China (HK) Charitable Foundation will come to an end in December 2024. The Agency must actively seek new funding to sustain the centre and the services that are provided to Yuen Long and surrounding communities so that service users can continue to benefit from non-violent communication techniques.

The implementation of new approach to the apportionment of central administrative costs for non-subvented services starting from April 2024 will pose pressure on HH to source more unrestricted funding. We will need to use different approaches and strategies to secure more stable ongoing funding and also impart on funders the importance of their support to central administrative costs with increase to the amounts allocated to those expenses.

Manpower shortage continued to hit hard on the Agency's operation last year. We are grateful for the concerted efforts of our staff who did their best to maintain the quality of services and proactively partnered with various community collaborators. The retention of a quality and stable workforce will continue to be challenging under a labour market of imbalance supply of social workers in the coming years. The Board, Staffing Committee and senior management will continue to work closely on providing and adopting a working environment that attracts and retains talents, provides good staff training, and plan for transferring of knowledge and experience across the different service units.

### Future Focus

Child abuse cases continue to emerge during the year in alarming numbers and warrants HH's attention. With the imminent implementation of mandatory reporting of suspected child abuse in early 2026, HH plans to strengthen staff's knowledge and skills for early detection of suspected child abuse and be prepared to be able to provide timely assistance to children who are at risk of violence. We will explore more resources and expand our school screening services on children and parenting education to support the needy families, school personnel, community organizations and the general public to protect our young generations from all forms of harm.

The supportive service for men is also our paramount concern. The 3-year HKJC sponsored Project Ocean launched at the end of 2023, through collaboration with different community partners, has successfully outreached to this important target group in high risks districts of Tin Shui Wai, Sham Shui Po and Kwun Tong. We hope to be able to establish connection with them so that they will seek immediate help at times of crisis, and to boost their resilience and general well-being to decrease the risk of domestic abuse.

Raising community awareness on identifying abusive relationships is crucial to protect individuals and families from tragedies. We plan to put out an enhanced and more user-friendly "intimate partner violence risk self-assessment" on the Agency's website which will hopefully encourage more of the public to practice self-protection and help seeking behavior. The data collected will also help HH to pace the need and develop more effective domestic violence prevention services,
